

#### CFS "Babies" grow up

CFS recently received an update on Canaan, who was placed with his family in 2009. His mother wrote:

Jerry! How are you? Can you believe Canaan is about to be 11 in a couple of weeks? Canaan knows who you are because we talk about how amazing you are and he'd love to meet you one day.

Canaan asked me out of the blue this





morning if I had told you that last spring I took him and his sister Judah to the mission I work for in Haiti. So here I am writing you.

I took the kids with me to Haiti last March via Missionary Flights International from Ft. Pierce, FL to Pignon, Haiti. Our mission has the 4th largest hospital in Haiti, 9 Christian primary schools (aka H.E.L.P.) with 1400-2400 total students on any given year, we've dug over 2500 clean water wells in the region, a Pastoral Training program, evangelism program, sustainable farm, etc. While Canaan was there, he was able to visit many of our



schools, play with local children, ride in the back of a pickup truck which he thought was amazing, take small toys to children all over the countryside,





help take food and clothes to people at their homes in the countryside, worship with people, etc. I've attached some photos.

#### **Update** on Jasmine

Last fall, CFS Caseworker Jasmine Pierce was diagnosed with triple negative breast cancer. Following her chemo treatments, Jasmine successfully completed her surgery and reconstruction surgery.

And as of about August, she has been able to be back with us full-time.



The timing for Jasmine's return was just in time for a larger influx of expectant moms due soon.

She continues to work with moms in Gainesville and

Ocala. Several trips to Jacksonville were made by Jasmine to expectant moms, and San Jose Church of Christ has graciously provided a place to meet!

Jasmine recently joined an adoptive family, adopted child, birth mother, birth grandmother and sister for an outing at the zoo!

#### → Hospital limitations

Each hospital has visitation rules, which have become stricter this year. Landon, placed in May, was allowed



only one visitor his entire stay. Dad did not get to meet him until he left the hospital! Preston, placed in July, was allowed mom or dad, but not at the same time.

CFS Caseworkers were not allowed to be with the Birth Mother during her hospital stay. Strict limitation on visita-

tion was enforced except during signing of paperwork for the adoptive placement.



#### → 6 feet and masked

In our office, when we are at our desk, we are more than 6 feet apart. As Jasmine and Jerry work in a variety of loca-

tions with new people, caution is best to keep everyone healthy.

Faith was very alert during her finalization hearing, and brought Judge Ferrero (at right) to tears! First time parents Omoniyi & Gloria are all smiles.




**Cole** peeks up from his mother's arms. After an early morning court hearing, **Steven & Kimberly** & older son, **Corbin**, were happy the new addition was official!

CFS has remained open throughout the pandemic. Though travel has been more limited and required social distancing & masks, we have been blessed with the opportunity to meet and work with many moms.






