CFS Dream List!

Everyone needs a little *cheer* right now. In spite of all that we as a nation are going through, **God continues** to work! He has provided just enough families and just enough funds to help provide forever Christian homes for these 9 babies. Here is a quick recap of **2020** (more detailed in our "End-of-Year" report next month):

- ◆ 127 moms counseled (excluding fathers and extended families)
- ♦ 985 case management hours



- ♦ 30,101 miles driven
- ◆ Avidly worked with 19 moms towards an adoption plan
- ◆ 9-moms placed for adoption
- ◆ Successful return of case-worker (Jasmine) following cancer surgeries
- ♦ No positive Covid tests by caseworkers in spite of continued travel, working with moms, numerous hospital visits, etc.
- ◆ None of our moms came down with Covid
- ◆ Prospective adoptive families more open to a variety of babies

A couple of people expressed disappointment with CFS this year. They felt like we had strayed from our positive reporting to "begging for more money." This comes in spite of the fact that 2020 has knowingly



been a difficult year for most when it comes to fundraising and continuing services. With this critique in mind, I will not be like a child at Christmas that "asks for more and more" even though it may be needed.

Instead, this is a longrange vision of what

I perceive as honoring the Lord's commands in caring for the Fatherless, being Evangelistic, and Serving community needs.

Early afternoon one Friday in November, a hospital called **CFS** about a **Safe Haven baby**. Mom safely delivered her daughter. After speaking with the Hospital Social Worker about her options for this newborn, mom opted to place the baby for adoption. Under the Safe Haven Act of Florida Law, a qualified adoption agency or attorney must be contacted to take guardianship of the baby. Jerry and Jasmine headed to the hospital to meet the baby.

The next day, the CFS caseworker on call (Jasmine) received a call from a **mom at a hospital**. She had delivered a boy. A Hospital Social Worker discussed options for the baby with this new mom, as **she wanted to place him in a Christian home**. Jasmine alerted Jerry to this new mom and baby. Jerry arrived within a few hours of the call to counsel the mom on what adoption would look like for her. Jerry and Donna returned to complete this mom's adoption paperwork the following day.

A busy, fulfilling, weekend for CFS! Thank you for making a difference in the lives of moms, their babies, and adoptive families!

court proceedings were held via ZOOM, with each party "held" in an electronic waiting room.


