14 of these women made an adoption plan

6 placed their child for adoption

The average age of the women who placed their child for adoption was 27 years.

67% of CFS birth mothers had other children

67% of CFS birth mothers had significant financial need

67% were employed part time

Of the babies placed:

50% Caucasian
34% mixed race
16% African American

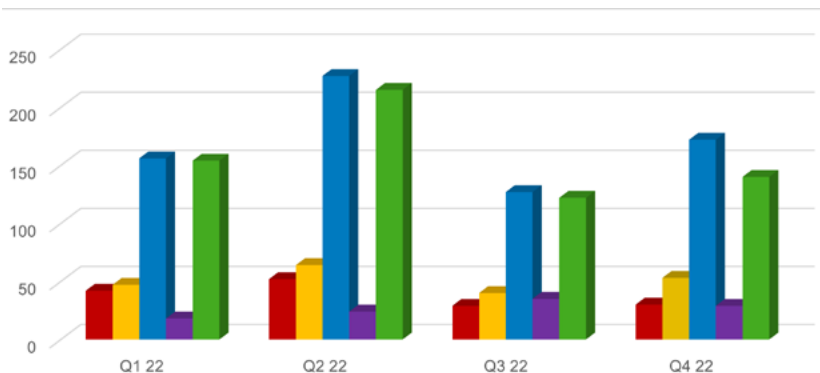

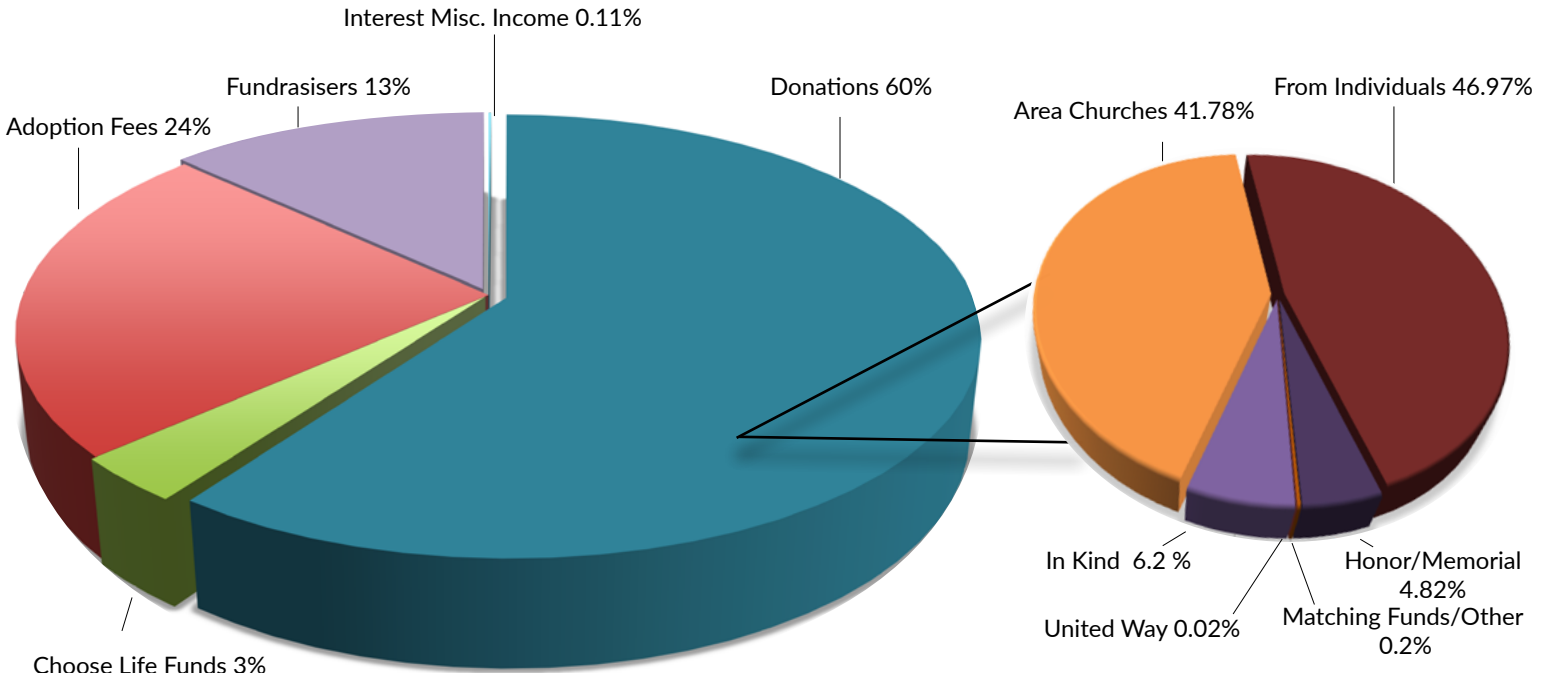
After the overturn of Roe vs. Wade in June, we, and many of our donors, thought CFS would have a wave of new clients. Instead, CFS had fewer contacts with expectant women following the summer.

We noticed that women with unplanned pregnancies are less likely to want to meet in person than those of the past. This change may be a generational shift, with their preference being to email or text with caseworkers.

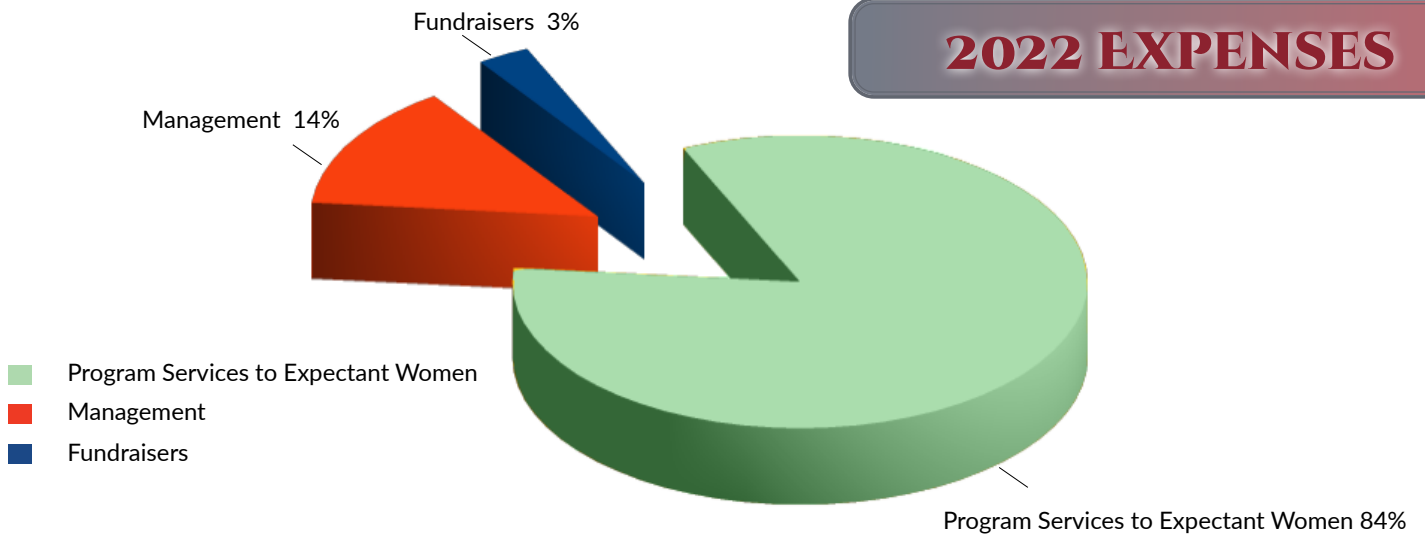

Details of donors breakdown

CFS noted an increase of 20.7% area church contributions, attributed to one congregation. The church home of this body of believers closed in 2022 and we feel fortunate to have been blessed by their one time provision. The Baby Bottle Boomerang fundraiser was held at two churches, an 89% decrease from past church involvement. Changes in fellowships which began in 2020 continue to have an affect on CFS being able to speak in person to like minded Christians.

WAIT TIME FOR ADOPTIVE FAMILIES

22 Couples were on the CFS Adoptive Family wait list in 2022, waiting, on average, 9.5 months for a child placement.

Couples who

- Received a child placement through CFS waited ----- 7 months, on average.
- Received a placement from another agency waited -----11 months, on average.
- Did not receive a placement in 2022 waited -----10 months, on average.

The one constant in 2022 was change. The decision of the Supreme Court, adapting to meet women with new technology, changes in CSF administration, and acknowledging a decline in support from churches. We trust in Him who provides for the fatherless through donors such as you.
